▶ Review the degree audit that will be sent by your adviser. (You will receive your degree audit approximately two weeks after getting this checklist; therefore, you will not be able to complete this step until that time.)

▶ Select the courses that you'd like to take.

▶ After you receive your Penn State Access Account, log in to eLion and find your first date to register for courses by going to "Schedule" and then "Registration Calendar."
