



Be prepared to request course syllabi from any academic institutions you have attended in the past. We may ask for this so that Penn State faculty can evaluate how your past course work aligns with our current curriculum. We'll provide additional information with your offer, but it's a good idea to start contacting your previous colleges and universities ahead of time so you understand their processes for requesting syllabi.

CREDIT EVALUATION PERIOD

You may be required to send a syllabus for each course taken from 2000 to the present, as requested. Academic departments make final credit transfer decisions, and your final evaluation may not be complete until the end of your first semester.

WE'LL BE IN TOUCH

After you accept your offer in MyPennState, you'll begin receiving communications about your next steps. Once you're assigned an academic adviser, they will help you understand how your transfer credits will apply to your degree program. You may receive some communications to your personal email account at first. You will receive a Penn State email account before course registration begins for your first semester, and this is where communications from Penn State will be sent going forward.
